To all NKRC members and visitors,

Due to the COVID-19 global pandemic. On the advice of Karting Australia and the NSW Office of Sport, The Newcastle Kart Racing Club will be enacting several measures for the health and wellbeing of our club members, visitors and staff. While these temporary measures may cause some inconvenience, our number one focus is the health and safety of our karter's, officials, staff and visitors.

As it stands now, because karting is an outdoor sport, our attendees are spread out over quite a large area and that it is more participation based rather than spectator based. It appears that most of our events will not be significantly impacted by government regulation at this stage. We are also still open for practice on Saturdays and Sundays. That of course may change, and it could change very quickly. Please keep an eye on your email, our website and Facebook for updates.

We are also enacting extra cleaning and safety procedures throughout the complex including the Café, dining area, bathrooms, control tower etc. and once stock arrive, we will be placing hand sanitiser stations in key locations.

NKRC Café

As some of you are aware our club café has recently undergone some renovations and upgrades to improve and maintain the highest possible food preparation standards. Items such as pies, sausage rolls, donuts etc, will be prepackaged for freshness and safety. When standing in line at the café, please maintain a distance of 1.5 metre behind the person in front of you.

Bathrooms

Bathrooms will also be maintained with antibacterial hand soap and we ask that the electric hand dryers are used when possible. As there maybe periods of time were hand towels are not available. Due to the constant theft of toilet paper, new lockable toilet paper dispensers are being installed in some stalls, while the remaining stalls will be closed until further notice.

Overseas Travel

Karting Australia now require all license holders, officials, family members, supporters, crew, paid and volunteer workers at Kart Clubs and karting events to complete a Karting Australia Travel Register and

Isolation Form **at least 3 days before** these members of the Karting Australia Family attend their Club or a Racetrack.
