

2025 Newcastle Kart Racing Club Championship Regulations

1) Eligible Classes

Classes eligible for the club championship in 2025 are;

- Cadet 9, Cadet 12, KA3 Junior Light, KA3 Junior Heavy, KA3 Senior, Tag 125, Tag 125 Restricted Light, Tag 125
 Restricted Medium
- All classes are to comply with the Latest Edition of the Karting Australia (KA) Karting Manual and any approved addendums which can be found at karting.net.au

2) Drivers Championship

To qualify for the Club Championship, the drivers must meet the following requirements:

- Must complete either of the two
 - o Complete 2 working bees at a minimum of 4 hours each Parent or guardian may do this.
 - o Trainee Official for 1 whole race meet Parent or guardian may do this.
- A particular class is sponsored.
- All drivers must be a current financial member of Newcastle Kart Racing Club, including prior to the commencement of the first round in the championship and maintain their membership till the completion of the club championship.
- All 5(five) rounds count towards the championship. There is 1 dropped round allowed being your second worst round.
- Only 1 class per competitor. If 2 classes are run you must choose your preferred championship class.
- A minimum of 6 drivers per class on each round must compete.

3) Race Day Format

- All rounds will be contested using race format decided by the NKRC Board.
- All entries must be via KOMP. There will be NO LATE ENTRIES and NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.
- The race day format may be changed at the discretion of the NKRC Board.

4) Equipment

• Eligibility of equipment will be as set out in the KA Electronic Karting Manual (and any subsequent bulletins and amendments issued by KA)

5) Point Score

- All points accumulated across all heats and finals will be used.
- The final point score will be calculated across all championship rounds.
- No driver may transfer points.
- The point score will be posted after each event as soon as available.

6) Awards

- Rounds:
- Trophies will be awarded from First (1st) to Third (3rd) in all classes.
- Trophies will be awarded for first (1st) to third (3th) place for all nominated classes and medals for 4th and 5th place in Cadet 9 and Cadet 12.

7) Prizes

Monetary prizes will be given to eligible class winners for the championship

- 1st place \$500
- 2nd place \$250
- 3rd place \$150

Plus biggest cadet class, Junior class and Senior class will receive the following:

- 1st place 1 on 1 training day with HJM
- 2nd & 3rd place 1 team training day with HJM
