

Newcastle club championship regulation 2026



1) Eligible Classes

Classes eligible for the club championship in 2025 are;

- Cadet 9, Cadet 12, KA3 Junior Light, KA3 Junior Heavy, KA3 Senior (National weight), Tag 125 (National weight), Tag 125 Restricted Light, Tag 125 Restricted Medium, Tag Restricted Heavy, 4ss Senior Medium

- **All classes are to comply with the Latest Edition of the Karting Australia (KA) Karting Manual and any approved**

addendums which can be found at karting.net.au

2) Drivers Championship

To qualify for the Club Championship, the drivers must meet the following requirements:

- Must complete either
 - o 2 working bees at a minimum of 4 hours each Parent or guardian may do this.
 - o Trainee Official for 1 whole race meet Parent or guardian may do this.
- Volunteering a minimum (2) 4 hr shift in the canteen on race day
- Blood or Plasma donation with photo evidence of the sticker received sent to the club. (One additional working bee will still be required)
- A particular class is sponsored.
- All drivers must be a current financial member of Newcastle Kart Racing Club, including prior to the commencement of the first round in the championship and maintain their membership till the completion of the club championship.
- All 7(seven) rounds count towards the championship. There is 1 dropped round being your worst round of the championship.

- **A minimum of 5 drivers per class on each round must compete.**

3) Race Day Format

- All rounds will be contested using race format decided by the NKRC Board.
- All entries must be via KOMP. There will be NO LATE ENTRIES and NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.
- The race day format may be changed at the discretion of the NKRC Board.

4) Equipment

- Eligibility of equipment will be as set out in the KA Electronic Karting Manual (and any subsequent bulletins and

amendments issued by KA)

5) Point Score

- All points accumulated across all heats and finals will be used.
- The final point score will be calculated across all championship rounds with taking off their lowest point scoring round (Including 0-point rounds).
- No driver may transfer points.
- The point score will be posted after each event as soon as available.

Senior & Junior Club Champions

- The Junior and Senior with the most points at the end of the championship will be crowned our Junior and Senior club champion.
- Points are taken from all rounds of the championship besides the competitors lowest scoring round which will be dropped.

6) Awards

- Rounds:
- Trophies will be awarded from First (1st) to Third (3rd) in all classes.
- Trophies will be awarded for first (1st) to third (3th) place for all nominated classes and medals for 4th and 5th place in

Cadet 9 and Cadet 12.

7) Prizes

Monetary prizes will be given to eligible class winners for the championship

- **1st place - \$500 / Club Champion gloves**
- **2nd place - \$300 / Club Champion gloves**
- **3rd place - \$100 / Club Champion gloves**
